

FAQ's

Q: Why have other companies done this?

A: Many companies understand the urgency in getting essential life saving medication to employees in the event of a disaster. This program helps ensure that employees are not waiting in long lines at schools and hospitals for medication. This gives them direct access to the medication at your office location.

Q: How does this protect my employees?

A: In the event of a major terrorist attack or other biological agent release, your company can get rapid access to life saving medication for your employees. This service is provided free of charge and only requires your willingness to dispense this critical medicine.

Q: What is a "Closed POD?"

A: "POD" is short for "Point of Dispensing," a term used in public health to identify locations where medications may be quickly dispensed in times of emergency. An Open POD is a location where anyone may come to receive medications to protect against a specific attack. A Closed POD is a facility that is open only to a limited number of people, such as a company's employees and their dependants. By establishing a series of Closed PODs throughout St. Louis County, the Department of Health is better able to focus its staff efforts on operating Open PODs for residents not otherwise covered.

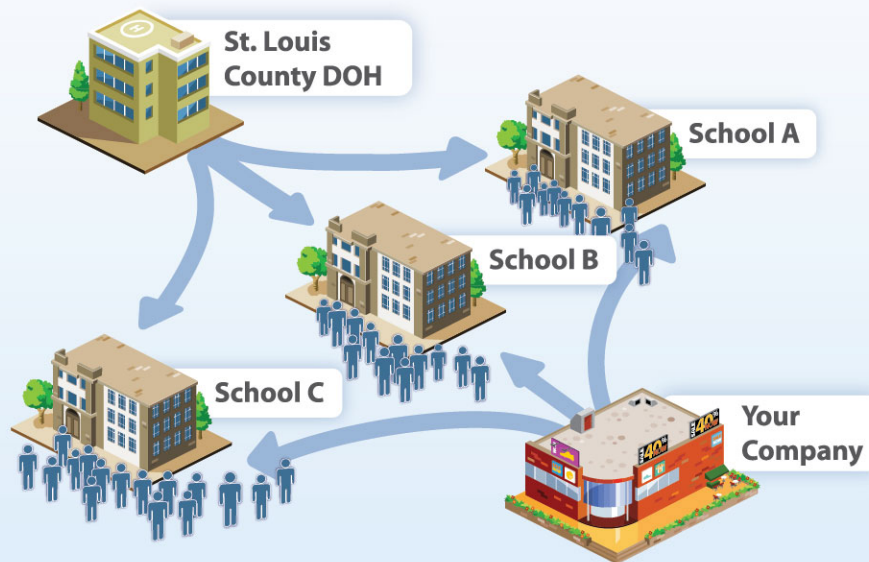

How it works?

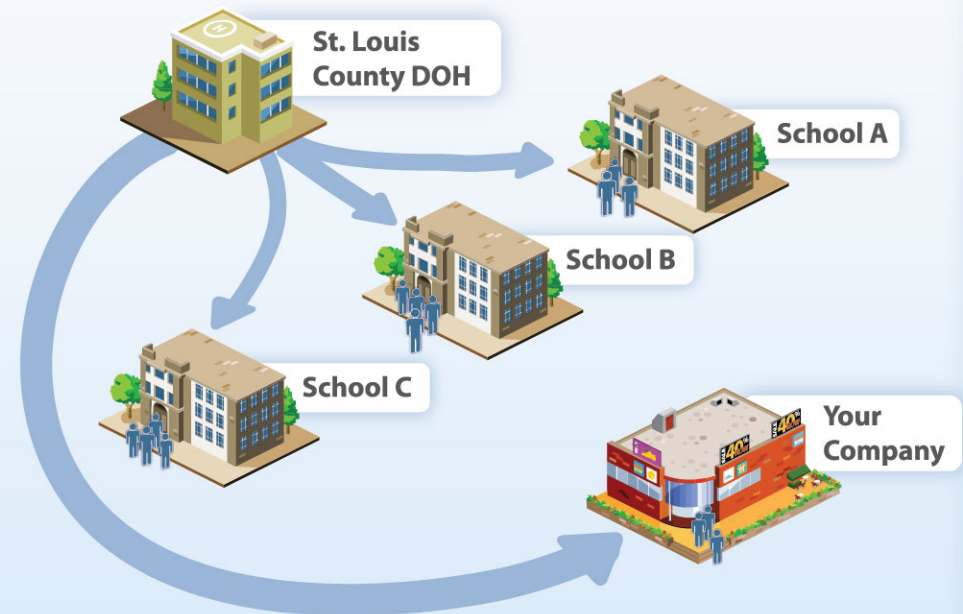
The current scenario:
